



## STANLEY M. ROWE ARBORETUM RULES AND REGULATIONS

- The Arboretum is open to the public 7 days a week during posted seasonal hours of operation. Please limit visitation to these times.
- Admission is free.
- Membership is encouraged and helps fund perpetual maintenance.
- All children under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult; young adults ages 16-17 may access the Arboretum without an adult, but may not bring minor children with them.
- Everyone must enter through the FRONT GATE or Pedestrian Gates.
- Parking shall be in designated areas only. No parking on the roadway shall be permitted.
- Dogs and other pets **are not permitted** anywhere on the Arboretum grounds. This policy does not apply to Trained Service Animals. Please see No Pet Policy for Service Animal Guidelines.
- Please honor signs respecting neighboring properties by staying in maintained areas of the Arboretum.
- The following are not permitted on the property – **No Exceptions:**
  - Littering
  - Discharging of fire arms
  - Horses
  - Camping
  - Hammocking
  - Removal, Cutting of any plants/vegetation
  - Running or bicycling
  - Hunting (except by special exception)
  - Alcohol
  - Loitering/loud music
  - Feeding of wildlife
  - Fires
  - Motorized vehicles on walking paths
  - Climbing or sitting in trees
  - Operating of drones

# The Stanley M. Rowe Arboretum

## No Pet Policy:

Dogs and other pets are not permitted anywhere on Arboretum grounds. The Arboretum No Pet Policy is for the safety of your pet, our living plant collections, and /or visitors.

This policy does not apply to Trained Service Animals.

**Service Animals are defined by the U.S. Department of Justice as dogs that are individually trained to work or perform tasks for people with disabilities.** Examples of such work or tasks include guiding people who are blind, alerting people who are deaf, pulling a wheelchair, alerting and protecting person who is having a seizure, reminding person to take prescribed medications, calming a person with post-traumatic stress disorder (PTSD) during an anxiety attack, or performing other duties.

A service animal is not a pet, comfort animal or therapy dog.

### Guidelines for Service Animals:

You may be asked to remove your service animal from the premises if the animal is out of control, poses an undue burden, or is a direct threat to the health or safety of others.

- Service animals must be leashed and walk beside you in the "heel" position (24inches) at all times.
- Retractable leashes are not permitted.
- Service animals must remain on the walking paths at all times.
- No aggressive behavior is allowed.
- Service animals shall not urinate/defecate in the gardens and natural areas.
- The service animal must obey your commands and not be distracted by outside noise, animals or people.
- The owner/handler is liable for any damages caused by their service animal.
